The petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for quashing of FIR No.62 dated 07.06.2018 registered under Sections 365, 452, 324, 323, 148 and 149 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 and Sections 25 and 27 of the Arms Act, 1959 at Police Station Sadar, Faridkot, District Faridkot (During investigation, offences under Section 365 of the IPC and Section 25 and 27 of the Arms Act have been deleted) and all subsequent proceedings on the basis of compromise dated 28.03.2019 (Annexure P-2).

Vide order dated 30.08.2019, the parties were directed to appear before the trial Court to get their statements recorded as regards genuineness and validity of the compromise entered into between them.

In compliance to the said order, memo No. 967 dated 18.10.2019 has been received from Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, Faridkot as per which the parties have resiled from their statement and it has been reported that the matter in question has not been compromised amongst the parties.

In view of the above said report, the instant petition is dismissed as not pressed at this stage.
