This petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. Seeking quashing of FIR No.434 dated 03.09.2022 under Sections 147, 149, 279, 323, 427, 506 of IPC, registered at Police Station Chandimandir, District Panchkula.

Reply by way of an affidavit of Mr. Kishori Lal, H.P.S., Assistant Commissioner of Police, Panchkula, on behalf of respondent-State has been filed in Court, which is taken on record. Copy thereof has been supplied to the learned counsel for the petitioner.

In paras 3 & 4 of the said status report, it has been averred as under:-

“3. That cancellation report is already prepared and ready to present before Hon'ble Court as complainant has already gave affidavit that no scuffle took place between the parties and this was just on account of misunderstanding.

4. *That otherwise also no harm caused to any of the parties and the sections mentioned in the FIR are compoundable and the complainant has already settled the dispute with the present petitioner”.*

In view of the above, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that since the cancellation report has already been prepared and ready to be presented before the Hon'ble Court, therefore, the instant petition has been rendered infructuous and disposed off, accordingly.
