This order shall dispose of the above noted two writ petitions as
common question of law is involved in both the petitions.

These are the petitions that have been filed under Articles 226/227
of the Constitution of India for quashing orders dated 15.05.2018, Annexure

P-4 in CWP-30673-2018 and dated 28.04.2018, Annexure P-4 in CWP-40391-2018 respectively, vide which the petitioners were placed under suspension by the Superintendent of Police, Hisar-respondent No.4.

In the reply filed on behalf of respondents in CWP-30673-2018, a categorical stand has been taken that the Inspector General of Police, Hisar Range, Hisar had accorded sanction for suspension of petitioner Saroj Bala pending departmental inquiry and the said sanction was accorded two days after the suspension order, i.e. on 17.05.2018.

Be that as it may, this Court is informed that both the petitioners have since been reinstated in service pending departmental inquiry.

Consequently, since the main challenge in the writ petitions was to the orders of suspension dated 15.05.2018 and dated 28.04.2018 respectively, which already stand revoked, no further orders are called for in the writ petitions and the same stand disposed of as having rendered infructuous.

Pending miscellaneous applications are also disposed of.
