Learned counsel for the petitioner argues that keeping in view the settled principle of law, the petitioner is entitled for the grant of full pension for completion of 28 years of service, which benefit though has been extended to similarly situated employees, but has not been extended to the petitioner for the reasons best known to the respondents. Learned counsel further submits that the grievance as has been raised in the present petition has already been raised in the representation dated 29.07.2022 (Annexure P-10) which is still pending consideration and the petitioner will be satisfied at this stage in case, a time bound direction is issued to the respondent No. 2 to decide the said representation by passing an appropriate speaking order.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Harish Nain, AAG, Haryana accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State and raises no objection for deciding the

representation dated 29.07.2022 (Annexure P-10) in a time bound manner by passing an appropriate speaking order.

In view of the pleadings in the present petition, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case or the claim being made by the petitioner in the representation, respondent No. 2 is directed to decide the representation dated 29.07.2022 (Annexure P-10) by passing a speaking order within a period of four weeks from the receipt of copy of this order.

Present writ petition stands disposed of.
