ANUPINDER SINGH GREWAL, J (ORAL)

The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No.190 dated 27.08.2018, under Sections 22 of the NDPS Act, registered at Police Station Chheharta, District Amritsar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the alleged recovery from the petitioner is intoxicant tablets containing Alprazolam with a total weight of 117.76 grams. The petitioner is in custody for over a year and is not involved in any other case under the NDPS Act.

Learned State counsel upon instructions states that none of the 10 prosecution witnesses has been examined as yet.

Heard.

In view of the above, especially when the petitioner is in custody for over a year, he is not involved in any other case under the NDPS Act, Covid 19 pandemic and the conclusion of the trial is likely to take some time, I deem it a fit case to grant the concession of regular bail to the petitioner.

Therefore, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the petition is allowed. The petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing requisite bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned.
