This is a petition filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking issuance of a writ of mandamus directing respondent No.2 to 4 to entertain and reimburse the medical bills detailed in Annexure P-4 and P-5, which is unnecessarily ignored and not entertained by respondents No.3 and 4 in spite of written complaint filed against respondent No.4.

Learned counsel for the respondents-State has submitted that the petitioner has been paid full amount of medical reimbursement as was demanded in the petition, along with interest. Hence, the present petition has been rendered infructuous.

In view of the statement made by learned State counsel, this petition is dismissed as having been rendered as infructuous.
