Case has been heard through video conferencing on account of COVID-19 Pandemic.

The present petition has been filed under Section 438 of code of Criminal Procedure for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.0194 dated 26.8.2021 registered under Section 407, 420, 483, 468, 471 IPC at Police Station Dhand, District Kaithal.

Reply by way of affidavit of Ravinder Sangwan, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Kaithal filed on behalf of the State is taken on record.

In the FIR, it was alleged that co-accused Virender Singh alias Binni misappropriated 135 bags of millets which were to be transported in the truck belonging to the petitioner by said Virender Singh @ Binni.

Counsel for the petitioner submitted that in compliance of the

previous order dated 2.11.2021, the petitioner has joined the investigation with the police.

Counsel for the State on instructions from SI Raj Kumar admitted that the petitioner has joined the investigation and that the petitioner is not required by the police for custodial interrogation. Moreover, the aforesaid misappropriated goods have already been recovered from the possession of Virender Singh @ Binni.

In view of the above, the present petition is allowed and order of interim bail dated 2.11.2021 is hereby made absolute subject to the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
