RAVI SHANKER JHA, CHIEF JUSTICE (Oral)

Learned counsel for the respondents submit that the authorities have already implemented the order/judgment dated 22.07.2019 passed by this Court in a bunch of petitions, lead case being CWP No. 6213 of 2016, titled as “Reet Mohinder Singh Vs. State of Punjab and others” and have removed the offending loud speakers, being aggrieved of which the petitioner has filed the present petition, thereby rendering the petition as infructuous.

Learned Additional Advocate General, Haryana, submits that on a complaint made by the petitioner, FIR No. 34 dated 23.02.2020

under Section 268 IPC and Section 5 of the Noise Pollution Regulation and Control Act, has been registered at Police Station Utawar, District Palwal.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in such circumstances, though nothing further survives for adjudication in this petition, however, the petitioner may be granted liberty to approach the authorities again, in case any cause of action survives or arises.

Taking the aforesaid statements of learned counsel for the parties and in terms thereof, the petition is disposed of.
