The instant petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India seeking issuance of directions to respondents No.1 to 5 to protect the life, liberty and property of the petitioner and his family at the hands of respondents No.7 to 14, who have entered into a criminal conspiracy to shoot the petitioner and his family and also for directing respondents No.1 to 4 to register an FIR under Sections 420, 419, 468, 471, 389, 387, 506 and 120-B IPC against respondents No.7 to 14 and their associates and agents for committing the offence of cheating, personation, forgery and for putting the petitioner and his family in fear of death and accusation of grave offence.

In compliance of order dated 25.11.2021 passed by this Court, status report by way of affidavit of Deputy Superintendent of Police, Circle Samana, District Patiala on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3 stands filed and the same is taken on record.

A perusal of para 10 of the said status report would reveal that Superintendent of Police Traffic, Patiala after conducting thorough enquiry on the application of the petitioner, submitted his report dated 12.04.2021 to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Patiala with the conclusion that the petitioner Jagjit Singh is a retired Police Inspector and opposite party Baljeet Singh and Kuldeep Singh are his two real brothers. They have their ancestral land at Samana, in which they have built a common marriage palace, shops etc. and have a dispute regarding division of their shares. The brothers of the petitioner have also filed a case before learned Civil Court and hence, both the parties are directed to pursue their matter before the said Court. Further in the said report, the Superintendent of Police Traffic, Patiala has recommended that to initiate preventive action against both the parties and to deposit their weapons, a separate letter be issued to Station House Officer, Police Station City Samana and the application be consigned to record room. On receipt of the report of the S.P.Traffic, Patiala, the then Senior Superintendent of Police Traffic, Patiala also agreed with the same.

It has also been submitted in the aforesaid status report that the petitioner is residing at Ludhiana and his brothers are residing at Samana and licensed weapons of one of the brother of the petitioner namely Baljit Singh, already stand deposited with arm dealer gun house and preventive action has already been initiated against both the parties. Moreover, the petitioner has been provided with police help line numbers as well as the numbers of the DSP, Circle Samana, District Patiala and Station House Officer Police Station City Samana, in case there is any necessity.

In view of the above, the instant criminal writ petition is disposed of with a direction to Senior Superintendent of Police, Patiala to look into the matter if there is any threat perception to the petitioner and his family.

Registry is directed to send a copy of this order along with copy of the petition to Senior Superintendent of Police, Patiala for requisite compliance.
