Prayer in the instant petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, *inter alia*, is for restraining the respondents from terminating the services of the petitioner as Social Studies Mistress in pursuance of impugned memo dated 22.08.2019 (P-11).

In response to the notice of motion, reply by way of short affidavit of Ms. Kulvinder Kaur, Assistant Director (S.A.-II), O/o Director, Public Instructions (SE), Punjab, has been filed in the Court by learned State counsel and para 4 thereof, being relevant, is extracted as under:-

“4. That it is respectfully submitted that in compliance with the aforementioned directive of this Hon'ble Court, the petitioner has been allowed to perform her duty and after scrutinizing the Recruitment record, the services of

the employee/petitioner have been regularized vide order no 20/139-2019 Estt.-2(6) (5178-Social Studies) dated 03.06.2020. Copy of order dated 03.06.2020 and the petitioner has already joined on 09.06.2020 in terms of order dated 03.06.2020. Copy of Joining report dated 09.06.2020 is annexed hereto as Annexure R-1 for kind consideration of the Hon'ble Court.”

Perusal of above averments make it clear that petitioner was re-appointed and pursuant thereto, she has already joined her duties on the post in question.

In view of the above, learned counsel for the petitioner does not press the petition any further.

As a result thereof, present writ petition is disposed off accordingly.
