This is a petition filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking issuance of a writ of mandamus directing the respondents to appoint the petitioner on compassionate basis in Petroleum and Explosives Safety Organization (Formerly known as Department of Explosives), Government of India, on Group 'C' post as per policy for compassionate appointment dated 16.01.2013 (Annexure P-11) with certain other prayers.

A perusal of the pleadings in this petition itself shows that respondents have not rejected the claim of the petitioner. Rather, as required under the policy dated 16.01.2013 (Annexure P-11), a list of the candidates, who are eligible for appointment on compassionate ground, has been prepared by the respondents. The name of the petitioner finds mentioned in the said list. Therefore, the petitioner cannot raise any grievance legitimately, at this stage. It is not even the case of the petitioner that some

person, whose father had expired after the death of the father of the petitioner, has been offered an appointment by the respondents.

In view of the above, this Court does not find any ground to interfere in the matter, at this stage.
