Case is taken up for hearing through video conferencing.

Through this petition, the petitioner seeks anticipatory bail in case bearing FIR No.200 dated 01.10.2021 registered under Sections 420, 465, 467, 468, 471 and 120 B IPC, at Police Station Bhawanigarh, District Sangrur.

Vide order dated 03.11.2021 passed by this Court, *ad interim* anticipatory bail was granted to the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that pursuant to the aforesaid order dated 03.11.2021, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Jagtar Singh, submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation and she is not required for any further investigation.

I have heard the learned counsel for the parties.

In view of the above, without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed and the order dated 03.11.2021 granting *ad interim* anticipatory bail to the petitioner is made absolute, subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438 (2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
