This petition has been filed by the petitioners under Section 438 Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.8 dated 09.03.2020, under Sections 365, 336, 506, 342, 323, 148 and 149 IPC and Sections 25/27 Arms Act, 1959 (Sections 307/392 IPC, 1860 and Section 3 SC & ST Act, 1985 and Section 395 IPC added later on), registered at Police Station Arif Ke, District Ferozepur. The petitioners apprehended their arrest at the hands of Police, in the above FIR.

Learned counsel for the petitioners has invited the attention of the Court to the order dated 09.11.2021, whereby, while issuing notice of motion to respondent-State, the interim protection was extended to the petitioners. The said order reads as under:-

“Learned counsel contends that the petitioners were granted regular bail in respect of the offences initially incorporated in the FIR and after that during investigation, offence punishable under Section 395 IPC was added in the final report u/s 173(2) Cr.P.C. and this has again given rise to apprehension of arrest.

Notice of motion for 04.02.2022.

Meanwhile, in case, the petitioners appear before the

concerned Court, they be released on interim regular bail.”

Learned counsel for the petitioners states that pursuant to the order dated 09.11.2021, the petitioners submitted themselves before the trial Court on 13.12.2021 and were admitted on interim regular bail.

The above position is not disputed by the learned State counsel.

Considering the above, the petition is allowed and it is ordered that the petitioners shall remain on regular bail and on the same bail bonds/surety bonds furnished by them before the trial Court on 13.12.2021.
