The petitioners have approached this Court under Section 482 Cr.P.C. seeking protection of their life and liberty.

Briefly the facts as alleged in the petition are that the petitioners had purchased some land from one Shoukat Ali. The said Shoukat Ali, had also entered into an agreement to sell with the private respondent no.4 who could not get the sale deed executed as he had no money.

It is also alleged thereafter respondent no.4 started harassing the petitioners for purchasing the land from the said Shoukat Ali by threatening the petitioners and moving false applications against them.

It is stated in the petition that even respondents no.2 and 3 have joined hands with the private respondents in harassing the petitioners.

The petitioners have also moved a representation dated 02.09.2022, to the SSP, Malerkotla, for protection of their life and liberty.

Accordingly, the petition is allowed and the SSP, Malerkotla, is directed to assess the threat perception in the present case by going into the representation of the petitioners and take action in accordance with law, within a period of 30 days the receipt of a certified copy of this order.
