Prayer in the present petition is for quashing the FIR No.138 dated 10.08.2021, under Section 67 of Information Technology Act, 2000 and Section 509 of IPC, registered at Police Station Manimajra, Chandigarh along with subsequent proceedings arising therefrom on the basis of compromise.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has been falsely implicated in this case and after registration of the same, both the parties have duly compromised the matter and nothing remains and hence, the prosecution of the petitioner would be nothing but an abuse of the process of the Court.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Amit Kumar Goyal, APP, UT Chandigarh, present in the Court, accepts notice on behalf of UT Chandigarh. Mr. Gursimar Singh, Advocate accepts notice on behalf of respondent No.2-complainant. He has affirmed the submissions made by counsel for the petitioner.

Learned State counsel, at the outset, on instructions from ASI Rajender, submits that the matter is under investigation and the report under Section 173 Cr.P.C. is yet to be filed.

Heard. As the matter is under investigation, the present petition is disposed of with liberty to the parties to pursue their alternate remedies as in accordance with law. The investigating agencies are directed to complete the investigation within a month keeping in view the overall facts and circumstances of this case.
