Prayer in the instant application is for grant of leave to file the present petition.

Application is allowed subject to all just exceptions.

CWP-21209-2022

The grievance raised in the present petition is that the claim of the petitioner with regard to the grant of maternity leave for which she is entitled for, is not being decided by the respondents despite the fact that the petitioner has filed two representations seeking the said relief.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has already delivered a child on 20.12.2020 but the claim for the grant of maternity leave for the said period has been kept pending by the respondents, which is causing prejudice to the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the grievance which has been raised in the present petition, has already been raised by the petitioner in representations dated 22.07.2022 and 28.07.2022 (Annexures P-7 and P-8 respectively) and the petitioner will be satisfied at this stage in case respondent No.2 is directed to decide the said representations in a time bound manner by passing an appropriate speaking order.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Harish Nain, Assistant Advocate General, Haryana accepts notice on behalf of the respondents and raises no objection with regard to deciding the representations dated 22.07.2022 and 28.07.2022 (Annexures P-7 and P-8 respectively) filed by the petitioner by passing an appropriate speaking order in a time bound manner.

Without going into the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with direction to respondent No.2 to decide the representations dated 22.07.2022 and 28.07.2022 (Annexures P-7 and P-8 respectively) filed by the petitioner, by passing an appropriate speaking order within a period of 8 weeks from the receipt of copy of this order.
