This is an application filed under Section 482 of Cr.P.C. for preponement of the date of hearing in the main case from 22.09.2022 to an early date.

Notice in the application.

On advance notice, Mr. Saurav Khurana, DAG, Punjab, appears and accepts notice on behalf of the non-applicant/State of Punjab and Mr. Sandeep Sharma, Advocate appears on behalf of respondent No.2 and have submitted that they have no objection in case the present application is allowed and the date of hearing in the main case is preponed from 22.09.2022 to today itself for final disposal as the compromise has been effected between the parties.

In view of the aforesaid facts and no objection from the opposite side, the present application is allowed and the date of hearing in the main case is preponed from 22.09.2022 to today and the same is taken on Board today itself for final disposal.

Main case

This is a petition filed under Section 482 of Cr.P.C. for quashing of FIR No.107 dated 02.07.2019 registered under Sections 420, 120-B of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 at Police Station City Kotkapura, District Faridkot (Annexure P-1) and all the subsequent proceedings arising therefrom on the basis of compromise.

In pursuance of the order dated 10.11.2021 passed by this Court, Judicial Magistrate, Ist Class, Faridkot has submitted its report, as per which, in addition to complainant/respondent No.2, there are four more victims and in addition to the present two petitioners, there are two more accused who have not been made as party in the petition.

In view of the above facts, learned counsel for the petitioners seeks permission of this Court to withdraw the present petition with liberty to the petitioners to file fresh petition after impleading all the necessary persons including the four victims as party.

In view of the above, the present petition is dismissed as withdrawn with liberty aforesaid.
