1. Prayer in the petition is for initiating proceedings against the respondents for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P-1, dated 31.05.2022, in CWP-37743-2018

2. A perusal of order Annexure P-1 reveals that while adjourning the case to 14.10.2022, it was ordered that possession of the plot be given to the petitioner without presently insisting on mutation entries in the revenue record vide settlement deed pertaining to the dispute qua the plot in question as regards the fraud allegedly played upon the petitioner when he was displaced from the State of Jammu and Kashmir.

3. At the outset, learned counsel appearing on behalf of the respondents on instructions from respondent No.2 states that the petitioner is free to contact respondent No.2 on any working day between 9:00 AM to 5:00 PM for being handed over possession of the plot in question subject to the outcome of CWP-37743-2018. The same satisfies learned counsel for the petitioner.

petition is *disposed of* as not calling for any action against the respondents under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 while directing respondent No.2 to adhere to the assurance held out by learned counsel on his behalf.
