VIKAS BAHL, J. (ORAL)

This is a petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for quashing of FIR No.76 dated 23.07.2022 registered under Sections 406 and 420 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 at Police Station Urban Estate, Patiala, and all the subsequent proceedings arising therefrom on the basis of compromise.

On 15.09.2022, this Court was pleased to direct the parties to record their statements in pursuance of compromise and the Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, Patiala was directed to submit its report. A report was submitted by the Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, Patiala to the effect that the parties had not appeared before the Court in order to get their statements recorded. Again on, 10.10.2022, this Court had permitted the

parties to appear before the Magistrate/trial Court to record their statements qua compromise and the concerned Court was directed to submit its report. The Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Patiala had submitted its report dated 26.10.2022 to the effect that the parties had not appeared in the Court even on the said date.

In view of the same, it is apparent that the compromise effected between the parties is not fructified. Accordingly, the present petition is dismissed.

Liberty, is however, granted to the petitioner to file a fresh petition in case, the compromise is still effectual and the parties are ready to get their statements recorded with respect to compromise effected between them.
