On 29.1.2020, it had been recorded that the writ petition has been rendered infructuous on account of constitution of a Regulatory Authority by the U.T. Chandigarh for regulating fee. However, the case was adjourned finally to 23.3.2020. Thereafter, Covid-19 pandemic intervened and the case was not heard. On 11.10.2022, it was adjourned as none had appeared for the petitioners. Today, a request for adjournment has been made on behalf of learned counsel for the petitioners, but the same is not justified in view of the orders noted earlier.

The writ petition is, accordingly, disposed of as having been rendered infructuous.
