The instant petition has been preferred under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of writ in the nature of Mandamus seeking directions to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner at the hands of accused persons mentioned in the complaint (Annexure P-2) with further prayer to direct the official respondents to take passports of the accused persons in custody.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he feels satisfied in case a direction is issued to respondent No.2-Commissioner of Police, Ludhiana to decide the representation dated 31.08.2022 (Annexure P-2) in a time bound manner, as no action has been taken on the same till date.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of Court, Mr. Rajiv Verma, DAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of respondent-State. Let three copies of the complete paper book be supplied to learned State counsel during the course of the day.

Without commenting upon the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2-Commissioner of Police, Ludhiana to look into the grievances raised by the petitioner in his representation (Annexure P-2) and to decide the same in accordance with law by passing a speaking order within a period of two weeks from the date of certified copy of this order.
