Learned counsel for the petitioners argues that the petitioners who are the guest faculty lecturer, have been transferred to a far off place without considering the fact that the post to which the petitioner can be accommodated are still lying vacant in the respective district where the petitioners were already posted prior to the transfer and could have been accommodated on those places.

Learned counsel further submits that keeping in view the salary which is being given to the petitioners, with the fact that the cost of living has increased, it will be difficult for an extension Lecturer, who has been transferred to a far off place to financially survive and discharge the duties.

Learned counsel for the petitioners further submits that the grievance of the petitioners have already been raised by the petitioners in representation attached as Annexure P-15 to P-20 and the petitioners

will be satisfied at this stage in case, a time bound direction is issued to the respondents to decide the said representation by passing an appropriate speaking order.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Harish Nain, AAG, Haryana accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State and submits that the representation filed by the petitioners appended as Annexure P-15 to P-20 will be considered as per law and the same shall be decided within a period of 10 days thereafter by passing an appropriate speaking order. Till then, the petitioners will not be relieved from the present place of posting or in case relieved, will not be forced to join the new place of posting till the decision of the said representation.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that keeping in view the statement of the learned State counsel, the present petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any furthers.

Ordered accordingly.
