In the present petition, the grievance of the petitioner is that he has been transferred vide order dated 28.08.2022 (Annexure P-2) but the petitioner is not being relieved from the present place of posting so as to join the new place of posting.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of the Court, Mr. Harish Nain, Assistant Advocate General, Haryana, present in Court, accepts notice.

Learned counsel for the respondent-State submits that as per his instructions, the petitioner was absent from duty since 19.10.2020 and the transfer of the petitioner on 28.08.2022 was only due to the fact that the petitioner had updated the portal so as to be considered for transfer but as, the petitioner was already not on duty, question of his relieving for joining the transferred place of posting does not arise.

Learned counsel for the respondent-State further submits that firstly the question as to whether the petitioner is to be allowed to join the service or not, is to be decided and only thereafter, the petitioner's request for allowing him to join the transferred post will be considered.

Faced with this situation, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the present petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further with liberty to the petitioner to approach the respondents for allowing him to join his service first so that, the petitioner could further pray for his relief so as to join the place of his posting.

Disposed of as not pressed with liberty aforestated.
