By an interim order, the appellate authority has granted stay, subject to deposit of Rs.10,00,000/- although, the amount of arrears of rent comes to Rs.26,80,494/-. Hence, no ground to interfere is made out.

At this stage, the learned counsel representing the petitioner prays for some time to deposit the amount, as ordered by the appellate authority, on the ground that the petitioner's wife is admitted in the hospital.

Keeping in view the aforesaid facts, let the petitioner deposit the amount within next 15 days.
