Present writ petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution, *inter alia*, for quashing the impugned order dated 18.05.2016 (P-13), passed by respondent No.4, whereby, petitioners were denied the benefits of Assured Career Progression Scheme dated 03.11.2006.

Learned State counsel has pointed out that in view of order dated 11.07.2017 (R-1 colly.) (pages 8 to 61), grievance of the petitioners has already been redressed; thus, nothing survives in the present petition.

Since no one is appearing on behalf of the petitioners, therefore, this Court is left with no other option except to dismiss the petition for non-prosecution.

Ordered accordingly.

Needless to say that in case, anything survives in the matter,

petitioners would be at liberty to move an appropriate application for recalling of this order within 03 months from today.
