Due to COVID-19 situation, the Court is convened through video conference.

This petition has been filed seeking anticipatory bail in case FIR No.67 dated 15.07.2017 under Sections 379, 120-B, IPC, registered at Police Station Fattudhinga, District Kapurthala.

On 03.11.2021, the following order was passed:

“ Submits inter alia that due to unavoidable reasons the Petitioner who was already on bail could not appear before the Ld. Trial Court on a solitary date i.e. 4th December, 2019.

Notice of motion.

On asking of the Court, Mr. R.S. Khaira, Asstt. Advocate General, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the Respondent-State. A copy of the paper book be handed over to him during the course of the day.

Adjourned to 01.02.2022.

In the meantime, the Petitioner is directed to surrender before the Ld. Trial Court within a fortnight from today, in which event he shall be released on an interim bail to the satisfaction of the said Court/Duty Magistrate concerned, till the next date fixed in this Court.”

Learned counsel for the State on instructions from ASI Rajwinder Singh submits that the petitioner is regularly appearing before the trial Court and was released on interim bail.

In view of the statements made above, no further directions are called for. It is clarified that the trial Court would be at liberty to impose such further condition(s), as may be deemed necessary for ensuring the presence of the petitioner in future.
