Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the respondent had allotted a particular station to respondent No. 4 which was not available to be availed as an option for eligible teachers so as to effect the transfer under the transfer policy but, in a totally illegal and arbitrary manner, the respondent No. 4 who was having lesser marks than the petitioner had been accommodated the said station and that too without considering the claim of the petitioner, which act of the respondent is totally arbitrary and illegal.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Harish Nain, AAG, Haryana accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State and submits that in case, the petitioner has any grievance qua the transfer of respondent No. 4 or petitioner claim the transfer to the said place, the petitioner is at liberty to move appropriate

representation raising the said grievance within a period of two days from today and in case, any such grievance is raised, the same shall be decided within a period of 10 days thereafter by passing an appropriate speaking order. Till then, the petitioner shall not be relieved from the present place of posting or in case relieved, will not be forced to join the new place of posting till the decision of the said representation.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that keeping in view the statement of the learned State counsel, the present petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further with liberty to the petitioner to approach the respondent by filing appropriate representation raising the grievance as raised in the present petition.

Ordered accordingly.
