The present petition has been filed under Section 438 of code of Criminal Procedure for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners in case FIR No.186 dated 4.9.2021 registered under Section 21(B), 21, 29 of NDPS Act at Police Station Dinanagar, District Gurdaspur.

Counsel for the State on instructions from ASI Jagdeep Singh apprised the Court that the petitioner has joined the investigation and is not required for any custodial interrogation by the police.

The petitioner was not named in the FIR which was registered against one Balbir Kumar relating to recovery of 6 grams of Heroin. The petitioner was named as accused only on the disclosure of said Balbir Kumar. Admissibility and relevance of the said disclosure will be tested only during trial. The petitioner is not required any more by the police for the purpose of investigation.

In view of the above, the present petition is hereby allowed and order of interim bail dated 3.11.2021 is hereby made absolute subject to the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
