MANOJ BAJAJ, J.

Petitioner has approached this Court under Section 438 Code of Criminal Procedure to seek anticipatory bail in case FIR No.53 dated 05.09.2021 under Sections 323, 324, 341 and 34 Indian Penal Code, 1860 (Section 326 IPC added later on) registered at Police Station Jaurkian, Tehsil Sardulgarh, District Mansa, Punjab, who apprehends her arrest at the hands of Police.

On 09.11.2021, this Court had passed the following order:-

“Learned counsel contends that the complainant Swaran Singh is a tenant of petitioner's father-in-law, namely, Bachittar singh and because of his strained relations with the husband of petitioner, they have been falsely implicated in this case. According to him, the offence punishable under Section 326 IPC was added subsequently and co-accused has already been extended the concession of interim pre-arrest bail vide order dated 25.10.2021 passed in CRM-M-44401-2021.

Notice of motion for 15.02.2022.

Meanwhile, the petitioner shall join the investigation and would come present as and when called for and in the event of arrest, the petitioner shall be admitted to interim bail on her furnishing personal and surety bonds to the

*satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer. The petitioner shall also abide by the conditions as specified under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
To be heard along with CRM-M-44401-2021.”*

Learned counsel for the petitioner has stated that in compliance of the above order, the petitioner associated herself in the investigation and cooperated during interrogation.

Learned State counsel who is instructed by HC Manjinder Singh states that indeed the petitioner has joined the investigation and is not required for custodial interrogation for the time being.

Considering above, the petition is allowed and the interim bail granted by this Court vide order dated 09.11.2021 is made absolute.
