CM-2996-CWP-2022:

The present application has been filed for preponing the next date of hearing in CWP-3465-2018, which now stands adjourned to 04.07.2022.

Notice of the application.

Mr. A.D.S. Jattana, Advocate, accepts notice on behalf of the non-applicants/respondents and raises no objection in case prayer made in the present application is accepted.

Keeping in view the above, date of hearing in CWP-3465-2018 is preponed from 04.07.2022 to today itself for consideration.

Application stands disposed of.

CM-3001-CWP-2022:

For the reasons mentioned in the application, the same is

allowed and the applicant/petitioner is permitted to place on record the documents, being Annexures P-30 to P-36.

CWP-3465-2018:

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in the present petition, the petitioner has raised more than one grievances and during pendency of the present writ petition, after re-consideration of the facts and circumstances of this case, 80% of the benefits being claimed by him have already been released in his favour. Learned counsel further submits that for the remaining benefits, the petitioner has filed a representation dated 05.02.2022, a copy of which has been attached with this petition at Annexure P-36, and the petitioner will be satisfied at this stage, in case the Managing Director of the respondent-Corporation is directed to decide the said representation dated 05.02.2022 by passing an appropriate order in a time bound manner.

Learned counsel for the respondents submits that the respondents have no objection in deciding representation dated 05.02.2022 (Annexure P-36), filed by the petitioner, by passing an appropriate order in a time bound manner.

Without going into merits of the present case or the claim raised in the present petition or in the said representation dated 05.02.2022, this petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondents to decide the representation dated 05.02.2022 (Annexure P-36), filed by the petitioner, within a period of eight weeks from the date of receipt of the copy of this order. In case, the petitioner is found entitled for any relief, the same be also released in his favour within a period of next four weeks of passing of the said order on his representation dated 05.02.2022 (Annexure P-36).

It is made clear that while passing the said order, the settled principle of law, which has been cited in the representation dated 05.02.2022, be kept in mind by the respondents.
