Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has already been interviewed provisionally and hence, the respondent be directed to produce the result of the petitioner so as to ascertain whether the prayer of the petitioner survives or the same has been rendered academic keeping in view the marks secured by the petitioner.

The said result has been brought in the Court in a sealed cover and upon opening the said sealed cover, it is found that the last selected candidate in the cadre in which the petitioner had applied, has secured 96 marks whereas the petitioner has not been able to secure 96 or higher marks, so as to remain in competition for appointment to the post for which the petitioner is competing.

Faced with this position, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the present petition may kindly be disposed of as having been not pressed any further.
