The present petition has been filed with a prayer that respondents No.2 to 5 be directed to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner and his family members, which according to the petitioner was at threat.

After the notice of motion was issued, respondent-State has filed reply and in paragraph-4 of the same, following averments have been made:-

“That as per the report received from the SHO P.S. Jaitu, without going making any comments as to the genuineness of allegations, necessary arrangements have been made to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner and his family. In view of the apprehension shown by petitioner, P.C.R. has been directed to keep frequent and effective patrolling toward the residence of petitioner. All

the I.Os/Duty officers of Local Police stations are specially directed to pay special attention to any telephonic call made by petitioner with respect to his threat perception. MHC, P.S. Jaitu has been given the mobile number of petitioner with direction to deal any emergency call of petitioner with priority. Further the special security arrangements would be done for petitioner at the office of M.C. Jaitu whenever any meeting would be held so that petitioner could not be prevented to attend any such meeting. With the above mentioned security arrangements, the complaint of the petitioner has been submitted to the hierarchy with recommendations to consignee the same.

Learned counsel for the petitioner very fairly submits that keeping in view the said averments in the reply filed by the respondent-State, no grievance of the petitioner survives in the present petition and the same may be disposed of having been not pressed any further.

Ordered accordingly.
