The petitioner is seeking interim bail in the case bearing FIR No. 56 dated 20.03.2019 under Sections 22/25/29/61/85 of NDPS Act registered at Police Station City Sangrur.

Status report by way of affidavit of Ajaypal Singh, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub Division Sangrur has been placed on record.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that marriage of Gurmail Singh, the younger brother of the petitioner is to be solemnized on 28.09.2022. The father of the petitioner has since died. The presence of petitioner, being elder brother, is required to perform the essential ceremonies at the time of solemnizing the marriage of the younger brother.

Learned State counsel has not disputed the fact of marriage of the brother of the petitioner which is scheduled for 28.09.2022.

In these set of circumstances, the petitioner is ordered to be released on interim bail from 23.09.2022 to 06.10.2022

subject to his furnishing requisite bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of concerned Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate.

The petition stands disposed of.
