The instant writ petition has been preferred by the petitioner under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, seeking issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari for quashing the final report dated 07.01.2022 (Annexure P-7) submitted by respondent No.3 on complaint made by the petitioner that had been uploaded on the CM window.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner fairly submits that any uploading of a decision on the CM window by itself is not a decision on the complaint. He contends that he would be satisfied in case a direction is issued to respondent No.5 - the Assistant Registrar, Cooperative Societies, Karnal, to look into the grievances/allegations levelled by the petitioner in the representation dated 30.11.2021 (Annexure P-5) and reiterated in the representation dated 25.10.2021 (Annexure P-11)

and to pass a reasoned and a speaking order by affording an opportunity of hearing to the petitioner.

Notice of the petition

Mr. Vivek Chauhan, AAG, Haryana, enters appearance on behalf of respondent Nos.1, 2, 4 and 5.

In view of the order that this Court proposes to pass, there is no necessity to issue a formal notice to respondent Nos.3, 6 and 7.

Learned State counsel appearing on behalf of the official respondents does not have any objection to the instant petition being disposed of directing the competent authority to pass a reasoned order after affording an opportunity of hearing to the petitioner without commenting the merits thereof.

Accordingly, without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of directing respondent No.5 - the Assistant Registrar, Cooperative Societies, Karnal, to look into the representations Annexures P-5 and P-11 submitted by the petitioner and to pass a reasoned and speaking order within a period of four months after receipt of certified copy of this order after affording an opportunity of hearing to the concerned parties.

Disposed of accordingly in above terms.
