The petitioner has filed this writ petition because allegedly a sewer pipe being laid next to his house has been connected to a pipe line discharging rain water. This is stated to be contrary to the relevant Indian Standard and also the Code of Practice for Building Drainage. Representations have, thus, been submitted but no action has been taken.

In all the representations a bald allegation has been made that the pipe line discharging rain water has been connected to sewerage pipe line. There is no evidence that infact the same has been done and, thus, no relief can be granted to the petitioner.

The writ petition has no merit and is dismissed.
