HARSIMRAN SINGH SETHI, J. (Oral)

Learned counsel for the petitioner argues that the petitioner who is the guest faculty lecturers, has been transferred to a far off place without considering the fact that the posts against which the petitioner can be accommodated are still lying vacant in the respective district where the petitioner was already posted prior to the transfer and she could have been accommodated on those posts.

Learned counsel further submits that keeping in view the salary which is being given to the petitioner and keeping in view the fact that the cost of living has been increased, it will be difficult for an extension who have been transferred to a far off place to financially survive and discharge the duties.

Learned counsel for the petitioners further submits that the grievance of the petitioner has already been raised by the petitioner in the representation attached as Annexure P-13 and the petitioner will be

satisfied at this stage in case, a time bound direction is issued to the respondents to decide the said representation by passing an appropriate speaking order.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Harish Nain, AAG, Haryana accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State and submits that the representation filed by the petitioner appended as Annexure P-13 will be considered as per law and the same shall be decided within a period of 10 days thereafter by passing an appropriate speaking order. The petitioner will not be relieved from the present place of posting or in case relieved, will not be forced to join the new place of posting till the decision of the said representation.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that keeping in view the statement of the learned State counsel, the present petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further.

Ordered accordingly.
