1. Prayer in the petition is for initiating proceedings against the respondent for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P-1, dated 07.10.2021, in CRWP-9406-2021.

2. A perusal of order Annexure P-1 reveals that CRWP-9406-2021, was disposed of by directing the respondent to consider the representation filed by the petitioner and to decide the same in accordance with law, within two weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order and in case any action was required to be taken against any person, to take the same, in accordance with law.

3. Learned AAG, Punjab, has filed copy of compliance report dated 20.10.2022, along with order Annexure R-1/T i.e. letter dated 21.10.2021, addressed by the Senior Superintendent of Police, Jalandhar, to the Registrar (Criminal) of this Court, mentioning therein that the allegations as leveled by the petitioner in his representation had not been

substantiated by him in the inquiry conducted and that the Inquiry Officer

had not recommended any action in the matter, accordingly the representation had been filed. The same is taken on record. Copy thereof supplied to learned counsel for the petitioner, who on perusal thereof states that in the circumstances, the petitioner does not press the instant petition but prays for grant of liberty to challenge the action of the respondent in filing therepresentation vide order Annexure R1/T, by way of appropriate proceedings, in accordance with law.

4. In view of the position noted above as well as statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the instant petition is *disposed of* as not calling for any action against the respondent under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, while granting liberty to the petitioner as prayed for.
