[1] Prayer in the petition is for initiation of proceedings against the respondent for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P-1, dated 12.05.2022, in CWP No.4916 of 2022 in case titled as '**Ravi Bhushan and others** versus **The Principal Secretary to Govt. of Haryana and others**'.

[2] Learned DAG, Haryana, has produced copy of speaking order dated 15.07.2022, rejecting the claim of the petitioners as contained in representation dated 21.09.2022. The same is taken on record. Copy thereof supplied to learned counsel for the petitioners, who states that in the circumstances, the petitioners do not press the instant petition but pray for grant of liberty to the petitioners to challenge order dated 15.07.2022, by way of appropriate proceedings, in accordance with law.

[3] In view of the position noted above, as well as statement of learned counsel for the petitioners, the instant petition is *disposed of* as not

calling for any action against the respondent under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, while granting liberty to the petitioners, as prayed for.
