Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner was dismissed from service after holding an enquiry and the allegations which were alleged against the petitioner in the enquiry proceedings, were the same for which the petitioner was also facing criminal proceedings. Learned counsel submits that though after holding the departmental proceedings, the petitioner was dismissed from service but in the criminal proceedings, the petitioner was exonerated, hence, the petitioner had approached the respondents by filing a revision application so as to reconsider the order of punishment imposed.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the revision application (Annexure P-12) is pending consideration with the respondents and the petitioner only prays that the respondents be directed to decide the same expeditiously in a time bound manner.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of the Court, Mr. Harish Nain, Assistant Advocate General, Haryana accepts notice on behalf of the respondents and submits that in case the revision application filed by the petitioner has not

been decided so far, the same will be decided by respondent No.1 within a period of 8 weeks from receipt of copy of this order.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that keeping in view the aforesaid statement of learned State counsel, no further grievance of the petitioner survives in the present petition and the same may kindly be disposed of as having been not pressed any further.
