VIKAS SURI, J. (Oral)

At the outset, learned counsel appearing for the petitioner restricts his prayer for deciding the representation dated 24.09.2021 (Annexure P-9) and legal notice dated 10.08.2022 (Annexure P-10). He submits that the petitioner would be satisfied, at this stage, if the aforesaid representation is decided by passing a speaking order in a time bound manner.

It is further submitted that the claim of the petitioner has to be decided by the third respondent, i.e. Deputy Registrar, Cooperative Societies, Bathinda.

Notice of motion to respondent No.3 only.

Ms. Ambika Bedi, AAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of respondent No.3 and waives service. She would submit that the said respondent/competent authority will look into the matter and will take a decision on the representation/legal notice of the petitioner in accordance with law, in a time bound manner.

Heard learned counsel for the parties.

Without expressing any opinion or going into the merits of the

case or the claim being made by the petitioner in the present petition or in the representation/legal notice, respondent No.3/Competent Authority is directed to consider and decide the claim made in the representation/legal notice dated 24.09.2021 and 10.08.2022 (Annexures P-9 and P-10, respectively), as well as the claim for interest on delayed payment of arrears, in accordance with law, by passing a speaking order within a period of eight weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

Needless to observe that in case, after the decision, petitioner is found entitled for any benefits, the same be paid to him within a period of four weeks thereafter, as per law.

The petition stands disposed of in the aforesaid terms.
