The petitioner has filed this petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari for quashing the transfer order dated 28.08.2017 (Annexure P-2) whereby the petitioner has been transferred from Amritsar to Attari-1681 Branch.

The counsel for respondents submits that the petitioner was transferred only at a distance of about 25 kilometers and the petitioner had even joined the place of posting since there was no interim order passed by this court. The transfer order had already been executed about five years ago.

In view of the above, the petition stands dismissed as having been rendered infructuous.

Otherwise also this court does not find any ground to continue with the present petition.

Dismissed as such.
