Through the present petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. the petitioner seeks quashing of FIR No.197 dated 07.10.2020 registered under Sections 406 and 498-A IPC at Police Station Kabarwala, District Shri Muktsar Sahib.

Since the dispute in the impugned FIR related to a matrimonial discord, on 17.12.2020 this Court had referred the parties to the Mediation & Conciliation Centre of this Court where as per the report of the appointed mediators dated 19.03.2021 the petitioner and the complainant have amicably resolved their dispute.

In the light of the above factual position and the law laid down by the Full Bench of this Court in *Kulwinder Singh and others Vs. State of Punjab and others*, 2007 (3) RCR (Criminal) 1052, this Court deems it just and proper to allow the petition and resultantly quash FIR No.197 dated 07.10.2020 registered under Sections 406 and 498-A IPC at Police Station Kabarwala, District Shri Muktsar Sahib and all proceedings arising therefrom qua the petitioner.
