The petitioner is seeking extension of parole under Sections 3 and 4 of the Punjab Good Conduct Prisoners (Temporary Release) Act, 1962 for a period of 45 days as his father namely Jagraj Singh met with Heart Attack and stent is to be inserted.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has surrendered back before the concerned Jail Authority on 14.09.2022 after availing benefit of parole. However, at the same time, the medical condition of his father became serious and the Doctor has advised for insertion of stent. The necessary medical reports have been attached as Annexure P-1.

Since the petitioner has already surrendered back before the concerned Jail Authority on 14.09.2022, the instant petition is disposed of as having been rendered infructuous. However, the petitioner is granted liberty to file fresh petition for grant of parole on account of serious medical

condition of his father.
