HARSIMRAN SINGH SETHI J. (ORAL)

Learned counsel for the petitioner argues that grievance of the petitioner in the present petition is that the benefits accruing to the petitioner after his retirement, including the GPF amount, be released to him by the respondents, along with the interest on the delayed release of the said payments.

Learned counsel for the petitioner very fairly submits though after filing of the present petition, all the benefits, for which the petitioner became entitled for upon his retirement, have been released to him by the respondents, but the interest on the delayed release of the GPF amount, to which he was entitled, has still not been extended in his favour by the respondents. Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that the petitioner be given liberty to approach the respondents to claim interest on the said delayed release of GPF amount, which has been released in his favour by the respondents after a delay of more than two years, by filing

appropriate representation.

Learned State counsel submits that in case any representation is filed by the petitioner claiming any relief, the same will be considered and decided by the authorities concerned in accordance with law by passing an appropriate speaking order within a period of eight weeks from the date of receipt of such representation and in case after the decision, the petitioner is found entitled for any benefit, the same will also be extended to him within a period of four weeks thereafter.

At this stage, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that keeping in view the submissions of learned State counsel, as recorded hereinbefore, no further grievance of the petitioner survives in the present petition at this stage and the same may kindly be disposed of as having been not pressed any further at this stage with the liberty as prayed for.

Ordered accordingly.
