Prayer in the present petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in a case FIR No.230 dated 6.10.2021, registered under Sections 323, 325, 506 and 34 IPC (Section 354 IPC added later on) at Police Station Tanda, District Hoshiarpur.

By virtue of the order dated 18.1.2022, while granting interim protection, the petitioner was directed to join investigation.

It has been contended by learned counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner has joined the investigation and fully cooperated and thus, the interim order may kindly be made absolute.

Learned counsel for the complainant has opposed the submissions made by learned counsel for the petitioner.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Satnam Singh has stated that the petitioner has joined the investigation and is no more required for further investigation.

In view of the above, the order dated 18.1.2022 is made absolute subject to compliance of conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. and the petition stands allowed.
