VIKAS SURI, J. (Oral)

At the outset, learned counsel appearing for the petitioners restricts his prayer for deciding the representation/legal notice dated 13.07.2022 (Annexure P-8).

He would submit that the petitioners would be satisfied if the said representation is decided by passing a speaking order in a time bound manner.

Notice of motion to respondent Nos.1 to 6 only.

Ms. Ambika Bedi, AAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of respondent Nos.1 to 6 and waives service. She would submit that the respondents will look into the matter and will take a decision on the representation of the petitioners in accordance with law.

It is pointed out that the issue arising in the present petition is identical to that raised in CWP-4993-2022 titled ***Rupesh Kumar and others vs. State of Punjab and others***, disposed of on 14.03.2022.

In view of the above, without expressing any opinion either on the merits of the claim raised in the petition or in the representation/legal notice made on behalf of the petitioners, the present petition is disposed of

by directing the competent authority amongst the respondents to take a decision on the representation/legal notice dated 13.07.2022 (Annexure P-8), in accordance with law, by pass a speaking order within a period of eight weeks from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.

Needless to observe that in case, after the decision, petitioners are found entitled for any benefits, the same be released to them within a period of four weeks thereafter, as per law.

The petition stands disposed of in the aforesaid terms.
