Through instant petition under Section 439 of Code of Criminal Code, 1973, the petitioner is seeking bail in FIR No.144 dated 29.06.2022 registered at Police Station STF SAS Nagar, Mohali under Sections 21-C and 29 of NDPS Act.

Learned counsel for the petitioner would submit that petitioner was arrested 29.06.2022 and till date challan has not been presented on the ground of non-receipt of FSL report. He prays that in terms of judgments of this Court, the petitioner on account of non-receipt of FSL may be released on interim bail.

Per contra, learned State counsel on instruction from ASI Gursewak Singh submits that FSL report has already been received and challan would be presented expeditiously.

Without arguing, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks permission to withdraw the present petition at this stage.

Dismissed as withdrawn with aforesaid liberty.
