As agreed, as per statements of learned counsel for appellant No.1, learned counsel for appellant Nos.2 to 4, learned counsel and representative of the respondent – Insurance Company (separately recorded), a sum of ₹6,00,000/- (₹ Six Lakhs Only) over and above the amount awarded by the Tribunal is allowed to the appellants in full and final settlement of the claim in this appeal.

Accordingly, we dispose of this case with a direction to the Insurance Company to deposit the crossed-cheques for ₹6,00,000/- in the respective names of appellant Nos.1 to 4, in the same proportion as per the spirit of the award dated 01.03.2014, with the office of the Lok Adalat of the High Court on or before 28.02.2022, in compliance of this order, failing which, interest @ 9% per annum shall follow on this amount till payment from the date of this order. The concerned Officer of the Lok Adalat Branch/Office shall issue proper receipt after receiving the cheque to learned counsel/representative of the respondent – Insurance Company. The appellant(s)' counsel/appellant(s) may collect the cheque from the office of the Lok Adalat.
