The petitioner herein seeks to issue a writ in the nature of mandamus directing respondent No.2 to decide his appeal dated 23.08.2021, Annexure P-7, filed under Section 25 of the Haryana Home Guards Rules, 1980, against the impugned order dated 24.07.2019, whereby his services have been dispensed with without providing any opportunity of hearing to him.

Counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner would submit that at this stage, the petitioner would be satisfied in case his appeal, Annexure P-7, is decided in a time bound manner in accordance with law.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of the Court, Ms. Kirti Singh, DAG, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents and would submit that the respondents will look into the matter and will take a decision on the appeal of the petitioner.

Let sufficient number of copies of complete paper book be supplied to her during the course of day.

In view of the above, the present petition is disposed of by directing respondent No.2 to take a decision on the appeal dated 23.08.2021, Annexure P-7, of the petitioner, within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order, in accordance with law, and convey the decision to the petitioner. In case of failure to do so, the officer responsible for the lapse would be liable to costs of Rs.20,000/- from his personal pocket, to be deposited with the Punjab and Haryana High Court Advocates Welfare Fund.
