The instant petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of the India for issuance of a writ in the nature of Mandamus directing the respondents No.3, 4, 5 and 11 to register an FIR on the basis of complaint dated 08.07.2022 (Annexure P-22) lodged by the petitioner against respondents No.6 to 10, 12 and 13

It is not in dispute that FIR No.181 dated 04.04.2018 had been registered *inter se* between the parties wherein after investigating the matter, a cancellation report had been filed by the investigating agency. The petitioner has, however, already submitted protest application/petition.

In view of the above, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks permission to withdraw the present petition with liberty to raise all pleas and objections before the concerned Court in due course.

Dismissed as withdrawn with the liberty as aforesaid.

Needless to mention that upon the petitioner raising all such pleas/objections before the competent concerned Court, an appropriate order shall be passed in the matter in accordance with law.
